13<sup>th</sup> John Gopet 300 where he is already settled on a southern  
branch of Conegochege

13<sup>th</sup> John Gladell 100 where he is already settled near John  
Gopet

16<sup>th</sup> John Beard 200 near Clouds branch on Conegochege  
on the south side of John Hart's tract

20<sup>th</sup> Archib M'Calister 200 On both sides of Conedogut near the  
upper part of Samuel Owen's tract  
[this tract is assigned to Robt M'nut]

20<sup>th</sup> Dan<sup>e</sup> Williams 900 Spring on the north side of Conedogut  
next above John Thomson's tract  
207. if his land is not  
at this date. Thompson's patented tract.

20<sup>th</sup> John M'Farlam 200 On the north side of Conedogut opposite  
to John Lickough

July 4<sup>th</sup> John Phillips 200 at Everson pine cave upon a branch  
of Conegochege within three miles of  
the falling spring
